The Conference Leadership Team (CLT) has the responsibility to prepare a World Service Conference (WSC) agenda that facilitates the active voice and effective group conscience of our fellowship.

In order to accomplish this responsibility, the CLT initiated the planning process for the 2022 WSC shortly after the end of the 2021 virtual WSC. The CLT members reviewed the evaluations from the 2021 WSC, and we thank everyone who contributed comments and suggestions; your input is valuable as we prepare for the next WSC.

The 2022 WSC will be held April 26-30, 2022 at the Westchester Marriott in Tarrytown, New York. All Conference members will be visiting Stepping Stones, and we are grateful to anticipate an in-person tour for 2022.

The CLT discussed Evaluation comments regarding Chosen Agenda Items (CAI) and agreed to include two 45-minute CAI sessions in the General Session. Also, as a result of the Evaluations, there will be corresponding numbers to match Conference sessions with Conference documents.

CLT was able to consider 40 suggestions for the 2022 WSC theme. Thank you to everyone who suggested a theme or keyword to consider. After a thoughtful discussion, CLT chose and the Board approved the theme for the 2022 World Service Conference as: Enhancing Our Recovery through Abundance, Unity, and Understanding. We look forward to seeing how you incorporate and use this theme in the coming year.
